HCPSS Family Emergency File Form - Please Complete

If you have not completed the Family Emergency File Form, we are asking you to make that a priority. The Family Emergency Form must be completed each school year. Even if your child's emergency contact is the same as last year, we need you to go into your child's account and either update or confirm his/her emergency information. Thank you to the families who have already updated/confirmed their child's emergency contact information in Family File.

Login to HCPSS Connect and select the Family File tab to review and, if needed, update your child's emergency contact, medical, arrival/departure information, and your preferences regarding data confidentiality.

User guides for HCPSS Connect account activation and password reset, as well as Family File can be found in Guides.

NOTE: You must have a valid HCPSS Connect username and password to access the Family File.

If parents/guardians forget their passwords, they can have HCPSS Connect email them a temporary password.

- 1. On the HCPSS Connect website, click the HCPSS Connect Login button.
- 2. Click the Parent/Guardian Forgot Password link.
- 3. Enter the email address used at the time of registration.
- 4. Click the Send Email button.
- 5. The parent/guardian will receive an email with a temporary password and a link to login.
- 6. The parent/guardian will click on that link and use the email address used at the time of registration and the temporary email to gain access.

Tips for School Success - Note from Guidance on Student Absence

Student absences are recorded on a daily basis, and until we receive a note from home, they are recorded as unexcused. A note from a parent must be submitted to the school within two school days of the student's return, indicating the date and reason for tardiness or absence from a regular school session. A doctor's certificate is required in cases of a long-term absence due to illness. A note should also be submitted to request early dismissal or exclusion from activities (e.g., physical education). If you are planning an extended absence due to travel, please submit the Extended or Discretionary Absence form, which can be found here.

Policy Corner - Attendance (Policy 9010)

Regular daily attendance is vital to the continuity of classroom instruction and participation in school activities. Therefore, students are required to be in school or to be attending a school activity each day school is in session. In recognition that situations do arise that necessitate absence from school, the Board of Education allows students to be lawfully absent for a death in the family, illness, a court summons, hazardous weather as determined by the Superintendent, work release, religious obligation, declared State emergencies, suspension, or for other emergencies or set of circumstances which in the judgment of the Superintendent or designee constitutes a good and sufficient cause for absence.
